## Objectives

- Propagating and spreading the great Razavi Culture
- Developing the activities in the fields of science, research, literature, and arts related to the lifestyle and various aspects of the character of Imam Riḍā (P.B.U.H.)
- Identifying, praising and supporting the producers and creators of the best scientific, cultural and artistic works in the field of Razavi culture
- Developing the modern Islamic civilization discourse

## Festival Sections

Section One: **Published Books**

A) The main subject(s): Imam Riḍā (P.B.U.H.) and his family – i.e. Imam Mūsā al-Kāzīm (P.B.U.H.), Imam Muḥammad ibn ‘Alī al-Jawād (P.B.U.H.), Imam ‘Alī ibn Muḥammad al-Hādī (P.B.U.H.), Imam Ḥasan ibn ‘Alī al-‘Askarī (P.B.U.H.), Imam Hujjat ibn al-Ḥasan al-Mahdī (P.B.U.H.), Imam Ḥussayn ibn Mūsā al-Kāzīm (P.B.U.H.), Aḥmad ibn Mūsā al-Kāzīm “Shah Cheragh” (P.B.U.H.), and Lady Faṭimah al-Ma’šūmah (P.B.U.H.). The eightfold fields:

- Razavi history and lifestyle
- Razavi sciences (Ethics; Ṭib al-Riḍā (P.B.U.H.) with two approaches toward the new and old medicine; philosophy; theology)
- Pilgrimage
- The Holy Shrine and sacred sites
- Qur’anic and ḥadīth sciences
- Jurisprudence and law
- Psychology, social sciences, and training and educational sciences
- Culture and Literature (poetry; story; plays; literary texts...)
- Fiction, drama, play, and literary writing
- Children and youngsters

The chosen works in every field mentioned above shall be awarded with the festival plaque, letters of commendation and valuable rewards and shall be evaluated based on the two age groups: “adults” and “children and teenagers”

B) Secondary subject(s): Modern Islamic civilization discourse (the manifesto of the Revolution’s second step; the Supreme Leader’s letter to the youth of Europe; infusion of Islamic civilization; countering Islamophobia; terrorism and fighting against it; human rights in Islamic and in Western civilizations; national production and using Iranian products; dialogue and peaceful coexistence with followers of religions; Islamic economy)

The chosen works in the said subject shall be awarded with the festival plaque, letters of commendation, and valuable rewards.

## Section Two: Digital and Audio Books

The chosen works in the said subject shall be awarded with the festival plaque, letters of commendation, and valuable rewards.

## Section Three: Academic Theses and Islamic Seminary Dissertations

The chosen works in the said subject shall be awarded with the festival plaque, letters of commendation, and valuable rewards.

## Section Four: Unpublished Works

The chosen works in the said subject shall be awarded with the festival plaque, letters of commendation, and valuable rewards. Furthermore, the festival’s secretariat shall undertake the publishing of the best chosen works in question.

## Section Five: Active Publishers

The active publishers in the field of Razavi culture shall be awarded with the festival plaque, letters of commendation, and valuable rewards.

## Section Six: Research and Promotional Journals

The chosen works in the said subject shall be awarded with the festival plaque, letters of commendation, and valuable rewards.

## Section Seven: International

The chosen works in the said subject shall be awarded with the festival plaque, letters of commendation, and the following rewards:

- The award of the international section, granted to the best authored works or those translated into popular languages on the main subject – i.e. Imam Riḍā (P.B.U.H.), and his family.
- The award of the international section, granted to the best authored works or those translated into popular languages on the secondary subject – i.e. modern Islamic civilization discourse.
- The “‘Ālim Āl Muḥammad (P.B.U.H.)” (The scholar of the family of Muḥammad) award, granted to the most active foreign publisher in the field of Islamic and Razavi sciences.

- Supporting the publication of the best works authored in a popular language on the festival’s main subject.
- Supporting the top institutes and publishers in the reverse translation movement (translation from Farsi into other languages) in the field of Islamic sciences and teachings.

## Schedule

- In the opening conference, the best works submitted by July 1, 2019 will receive the special reward of “Kirāmat Ten Days”. Furthermore, the said works shall be examined, critiqued, and introduced in the scientific conventions of Kirāmat Ten Days.

- From July 5 to July 15, 2019, coinciding with Kirāmat days and the celebrations of the blessed birth anniversary of Imam ‘Alī ibn Mūsā al-Riḍā (P.B.U.H.), conventions of critiquing and examining books on the Razavi subject shall be held on a daily basis. Furthermore, during this period (from the opening till the closing), every week one of the works submitted to the secretariat shall be introduced, examined, and critiqued in the presence of the judging committee, authors, pilgrims, university students, book lovers, and people involved with the media.
- Critique and examination sessions of the works of foreign authors shall be held via video conference.
- All critique and examination sessions shall be held via the video conference.

## Judgment

The received works shall be assessed and judged by experienced professors of universities and the Islamic Seminary.

## Exhibition

The works submitted to the secretariat in this period and the ones before shall be put on display on the opening as well as the closing ceremonies of the festival.

## Requirements

- The works submitted must have been published in the years between 2018 and the end of March 2020.
- Submitted journals must have been published during the past five years (2014 to the end of March 2020).
- Unpublished works” refers to works of scientific research, literary compositions, as well as corrected and refined works on the festival main, secondary, and side subjects.
- All participants must submit three copies of their work to the secretariat.
- Submitted works will not be returned.
- One person may submit more than one work.

## Notes

- The “valuable rewards” are as follows: grant for Hājj ‘Umrah Mufradah [minor pilgrimage] (first place), grant for pilgrimage to Iraq’s holy shrines (second place), and grant for a trip to the holy Mashhad (third place).
- The “‘Ālim Āl Muḥammad (P.B.U.H.)” (scholar of the family of Muḥammad) award is worth €1000 and the “award of the international section” is as follows: €700 (first place), €500 (second place), and €300 (third place).
- Authentic scientific certificates shall be granted to those participating in opening and closing of the festival and the book critique and examination sessions.
- All of the selected submitters shall be present at the closing ceremony as guests of the festival’s secretariat.
- The secretariat shall cover all the expenses of the guests, including transportation, accommodation, and reception.
